- Pre-wire panel assembly (wire-way, terminal blocks, relays, power supplies, etc.) on the bench and installed into the equipment frame for final wiring of sub-assemblies.
- Execute field wiring of automated equipment and perform work verification.
- Proficient in reading electrical drawings with little or no assistance.
- Basic knowledge of PLC and PC-based control systems.
- Use proper wire lengths and connectors to maintain a clean assembly.
- Apply proper stripping and crimping techniques to ensure good electrical connections.
- Ability to tighten connections with the appropriate tools.

- Layout, drill, and punch holes in various enclosures following an engineering print/layout.
- Apply precision measurements using measuring tape, square, scale, micrometers.
